Casual Leave and Sick Leave

Dear parents & students,

Kindly take a minute to read this REVISED and UPDATED circular as this is IMPORTANT.

Apply for casual leave

- 1) EATW now ONLY ACCEPTS one month prior application of leave as we believe most appointments / ECAs are well informed / arranged in advance. Any leave abruptly taken within the same month, or same day spontaneous notification of leave, is NOT refundable and ineligible for a make-up class. A valid leave application is eligible for ONE OFF *make-up class to be arranged that suits both parties. A makeup class of such could only be arranged subject to feasibility and availability but NOT obligatory. *All make-up classes need to be taken within the same month of absence. Failure to attend the make-up class for whatever reason is considered a forfeiture of such, and no further make-up classes will be rearranged.
- 2) Anyone expected to attend a class yet **not showing up** will be automatically deemed ABSENT, and regrettably, is not entitled to a make-up class or refund in any manner.
- 3) A maximum of TWO prior classes of leave / month is accepted.

Apply for sick leave

- 4) To avoid the least embarrassment / confusion, we would like to stress that <u>'same day notification'</u>, any ad hoc leave taken or classes cancelled that are initiated by parents for any seemingly valid reasons other than **sickness, will not suffice for the paid class to be debited from next month's invoice. It is also ineligible for any make-up in another class slot.
- 5) **Absence on the same day of class due to sickness needs a valid medical certification issued by a registered doctor/ practitioner submitted to EATW in the next class within a week before the paid fee of such a class is liable for a debit from next month's invoice, or a make-up class to be considered. Please note that **only a true copy or a photocopy** of the doctor's cert is regarded a valid proof of sickness, but NOT MERELY a WA image of the doc cert sent. Medication bags / pill pouches are invalid and unacceptable.

Withdrawal / Temporary Suspension

- 6) PLEASE have the courtesy to inform EATW <u>AT LEAST ONE MONTH PRIOR</u> (i.e. four classes excluding red dates) should anyone wish to withdraw / temporary suspend from a class without a confirmed return date. Please <u>DO NOT</u> "just disappear" as all class materials will still be kept aside for 'no-show' students. <u>All 'disappearances' will be counted as ABSENT and FULL PAYMENT WILL BE charged accordingly</u>. Students are obliged to pay a month's fee for hasty withdrawals without one month's prior notification even if the student is unable to attend any lessons at all.
- 7) To ensure apt communication, any application of leave / withdrawal is to be conducted between a parent / guardian and EATW either by phone or via email and WA / SMS. Any other means of notification e.g. verbal message / memo submitted through a child /maid is unacceptable and invalid.

- 8) All classes cancelled due to black rainstorm / typhoon #8+ / class closures advised by the EDU e.g. inclement weather conditions or courses disrupted / called off as such are NON-REFUNDABLE/NON-DEDUCTIBLE & INELIGIBLE FOR MAKE-UP.
- 9) EATW classes operate as normal even when typhoon #3 or amber / red rain warning sets in. Parents opting out at their own discretion will not have the unattended class refunded or made-up.
